Trinity Pines Dedicates River Lodge and Climbing Wall

In the summer of 2007, Adult Retreat participants met at the site of River Lodge to pray and claim victory for the construction within the year of a second lodge at Trinity Pines. River Lodge (pictured above left) is now complete and on line for use because of many hours of donated labor. The new bunk beds were built in Nampa under the careful supervision of Jerry and Dorine Nichols. Members from ROAM were on-site to lend support in completing this project.

Each room in the lodge is named for one of Idaho's beautiful rivers. Each lodge accommodates 48 campers and the design allows for a variety of uses. River Lodge is the second of four lodges to be built, eventually, in Elk Valley.

The Peterman Climbing Wall is a small reflection of the involvement of the Peterman family in Trinity Pines. Don and Ruth have spent a lifetime in Christian service pastoring churches, serving as chaplain for Boise Police Department, and investing in the lives of people. They have been involved in Adult Retreat through the years

as a speaker, leader, and encourager of the program to minister to the needs of adult campers.

Randy (son of Don and Ruth) and Linda Peterman have been involved in Trinity Pines since the initial decision to purchase the property. Randy's expertise as an attorney allowed the Intermountain District to purchase the property at a reduced rate through some tax incentives. The Petermans submitted the name Trinity Pines in the district-wide project to select a name for the new camp facility. Don and Ruth, Randy and Linda have provided financial support and contacts for many of the special projects at Trinity Pines. The Petermans have invested heart, soul, and finances to the success of Trinity Pines.
