THEME: "Christian Holiness – Living, Preaching, and Teaching"

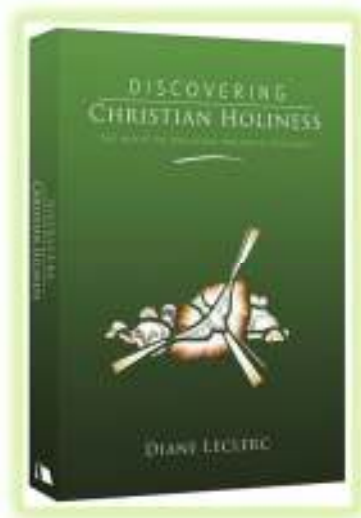
SPEAKER: Dr. Diane Leclerc
